1. Review Meeting Minutes on 13 May and 23 June 2016

EITI chair noted that most of the MSG member did not provide their comments and revision of the meeting minutes within a week. Therefore, EITI chair suggested to change the mechanism of future meeting minutes by indicating individual name or organisation.

Both Meeting Minutes on 13 and 23 June 2016 was approved.

2. 2nd Validation preparation

The Validator team is expected to visit Timor-Leste on 18 July 2016, it is intended to provide MSG with an assessment of EITI implementation in Timor-Leste against EITI Standard. Most of information including email correspondence for upcoming validation preparation and validation process guidelines have circulated to MSG.

Draft schedule of the meeting with the Validator team have sent to MSG mostly confirmed their availability.

EITI Chair comments regarding to unmet requirement (3.2, 3.3 and 4.7) ANPM have strive to communicate within the industries and have internal discussion particular Eni in order to provide Production and Export volume and also Revenue Stream as CoP already provided the data required and it has been published at ANPM website.

3. Review and approve ToR for IA

Inclusion sentence particular in relation to the Confidential Agreement clause as following:

The Independent Administrator must enter into a Confidentiality Agreement with <u>each</u> reporting entity. Draft report <u>may</u> be circulated to <u>the MSG</u> without disclosing any data <u>provided by a reporting entity</u>. The <u>final report and data</u> can only be disclosed <u>once it is approved by each reporting entity</u>. The Confidentiality Agreement must be executed by the Independent Administrator before it receives any information from the reporting entity and it must be on the terms and in the format specified by the reporting entity. Including safe guarding confidential information as per 2015 EITI Requirement 5.2 D.
